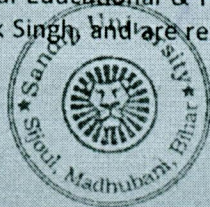

FOR ACADEMIC SKILL BASED TRAINING, COURSES, EXPERT LECTURES AND RESEARCH COLLABORATION

This Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) is made on 31st day of May 2023 between Sandip University, Sijoul, Madhubani, (hereinafter referred to as "SUM"), represented by its Vice Chancellor, Dr. Samir Kumar Varma, and Career Foresight, Patna (hereinafter referred to as "CFS") (C - DAC authorized training Centre), A unit of Sai Educational & Health Awareness Trust represented by its Chief Executive Officer (CEO), Mr. Ritwik Singh and are referred as "Parties"

WHEREAS, SUM is an UGC recognized university in Madhubani, Patna and is committed to providing quality education in various fields with global relevance and CFS is a C-DAC authorized training center providing training programs in various fields of Information Technology, C-DAC, referred as Centre for Development of Advanced Computing, is the premier R&D organization of the Ministry of Electronics & Information Technology (MeitY), Govt. Of India for carrying out R&D in IT, Electronics and associated areas.

WHEREAS, both parties recognize the importance of academic training and research collaboration to enhance the quality of education and training offered to students and to contribute to the advancement of research in the field of engineering and technology. Both parties intent to cooperate and focus their efforts on cooperation within area of Skill Based Training, Education and Expert Lecture.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Parties agree as follows:

SCOPE OF COLLABORATION

The Parties agree to collaborate in the following areas:

a) **Academic training and skill development:** CFS will provide training programs, courses, internships and workshops to SUM students in various fields of Computer and Information Technology. The materials and training cost will be delivered by CFS in collaboration with C- DAC (under the Ministry of Electronics & Information Technology, Govt. Of India) as per the norms and in consultation with SUM.

CFS will adhere to all the standards set by C-DAC regarding course training, supervision, and financial decisions.

b) **Research collaboration:** The Parties may collaborate on research projects in areas of mutual interest. The collaboration may include joint projects, exchange of researchers, and sharing of research facilities. Both Parties to obtain all internal approvals, consents, permissions, and licenses of whatsoever nature required.



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c) **Resource sharing:** The Parties may share resources such as research facilities, equipment, and software for the purpose of academic training and research collaboration.

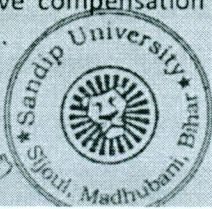
RESPONSIBILITIES OF SUM

- a) SUM will identify the areas of training and research collaboration in consultation with CFS.
- b) SUM will nominate students and faculty members to participate in the training programs and research collaboration.
- c) SUM will provide the necessary infrastructure and support for the training programs and research collaboration.
- d) SUM will ensure that the training programs and research collaboration comply with the relevant policies and regulations of the institution.
- e) SUM will promote the C-DAC training and relevant courses among its students.
- f) SUM will facilitate the smooth coordination between CFS and the students for successful promotion and enrollment of courses/internships/training's delivered by C-DAC
- g) SUM is not responsible for providing any financial assistance for the training programs or internships. Students who enroll in the selected courses/internships must bear the prescribed costs and security deposits (if applicable) according to the designated C-DAC norms. Any additional financial obligations will be discussed and handled separately between the two parties.
- h) SUM shall nominate a coordinator as a point of contact (POC) for CFS for proper operation of MoU.

RESPONSIBILITIES OF CFS

- a) CFS will provide training programs to SUM students in various fields of information technology.
- b) CFS will provide the expert/trainer for the training programs and research collaboration.
- c) CFS will ensure that the training programs and research collaboration comply with the relevant policies and regulations under the consultation of C-DAC.
- d) CFS will provide required financial support for expert lectures and training sessions offered by C-DAC at SUM. However, if a student wishes to enroll in a course to improve their knowledge and skills in a particular IT technology, they will be subject to the standard fees set by C-DAC.
- e) CFS will provide necessary training to the nominated faculty of SUM under the "Train the Trainer Program" offered by C-DAC.
- f) If CFS utilizes the personnel resources of SUM, then the nominated faculty and laboratory instructors of SUM shall receive compensation in accordance with the guidelines of CFS for the training programs they conduct.

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INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY

- a) Any intellectual property resulting from the research collaboration will be jointly owned by the Parties.
- b) The Parties will agree in writing on the ownership, protection, and exploitation of any intellectual property resulting from the research collaboration.

CONFIDENTIALITY

- a) The Parties will maintain the confidentiality of all information and data exchanged in the course of the collaboration.
- b) The Parties will agree in writing on the terms of confidentiality and the handling of confidential information.

TERMS AND TERMINATION

- a) This MoU will be in effect for a period of Five (5) years from the date of signing and can be extended on mutual terms and conditions.
- b) Either Party may terminate this MoU by giving thirty (30) days written notice to the other Party.
- c) Termination of this MoU will not affect any ongoing research projects or training programs, which will be completed as per the agreed terms.

GOVERNING LAW

This MoU will be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of India.

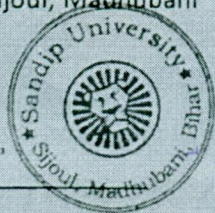


- b) Any amendments to this MoU shall be in writing and will be adhered to accordingly.


